Available Rank & Merit Badge Requirements

- Tenderfoot Rank, Req 7b – 1 hour of service (w/ approval)
- Second Class, Req 8e – 2 hours of service projects
- First Class, Req 9d – 3 hours of service projects
- First Class, Req 10 – Invite a Scout to join you
- Partial for Star Rank, Req 4 – 6 hours of service projects
- Partial for Life Rank, Req # 4 – 3 conservation hours
- World Conservation Award, Req # 2 – 3 conservation hours
- Soil & Water Conservation MB, Req 7.f (pending approval)



Hours can only be used for one requirement, and most require prior approval by Scoutmaster or merit badge counselor to qualify. Be sure to read the full requirements identified above in advance.
